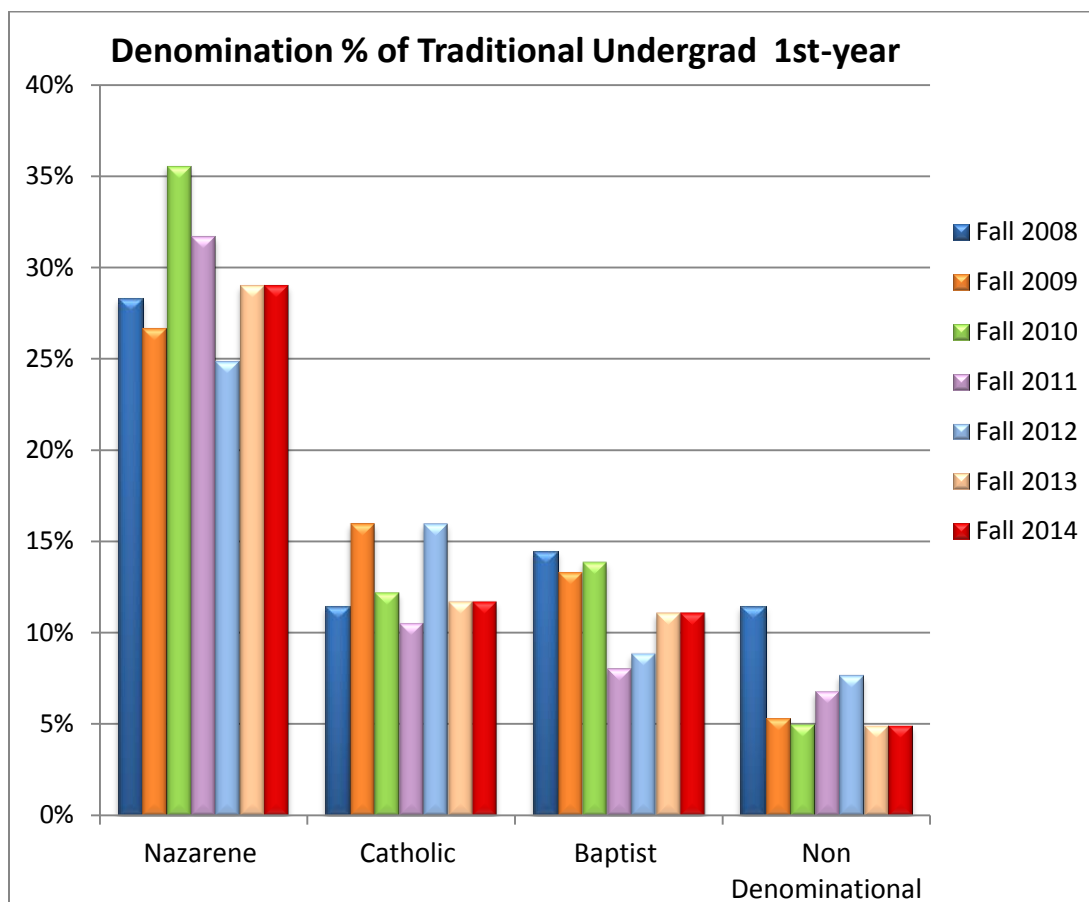

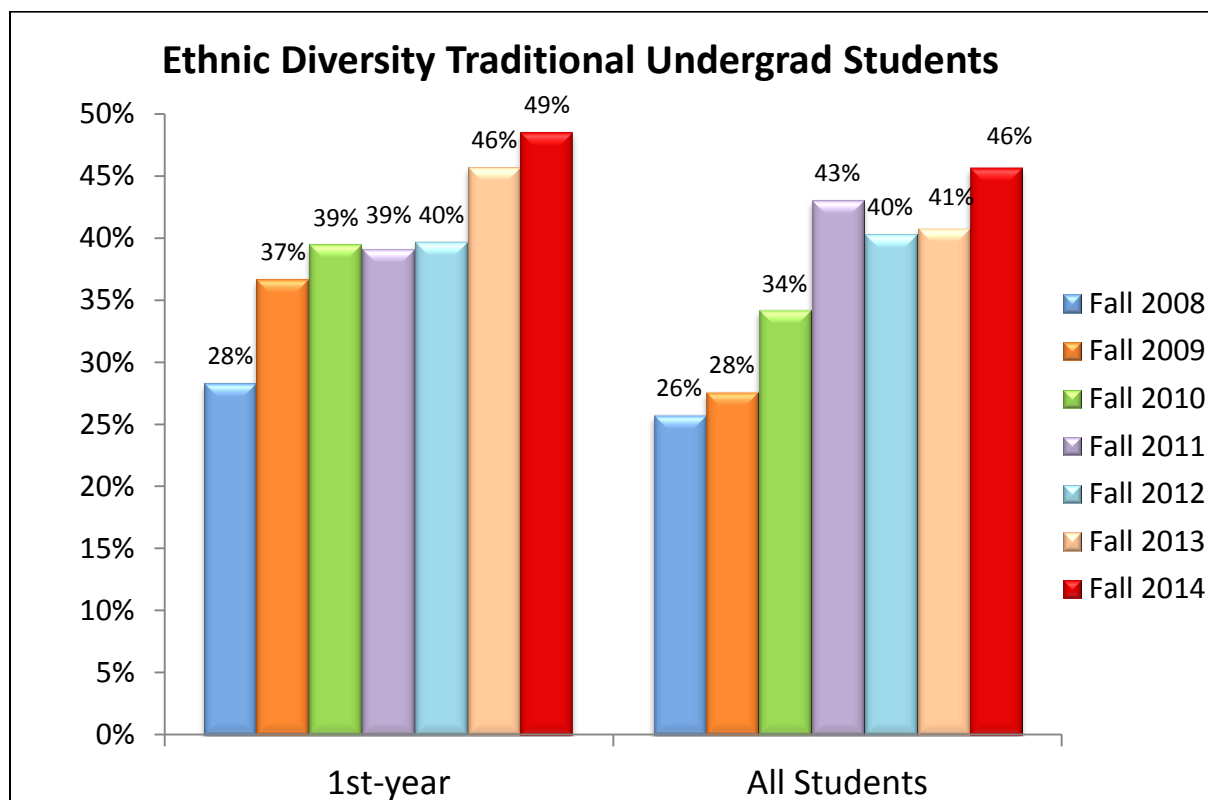

ETHNIC DIVERSITY

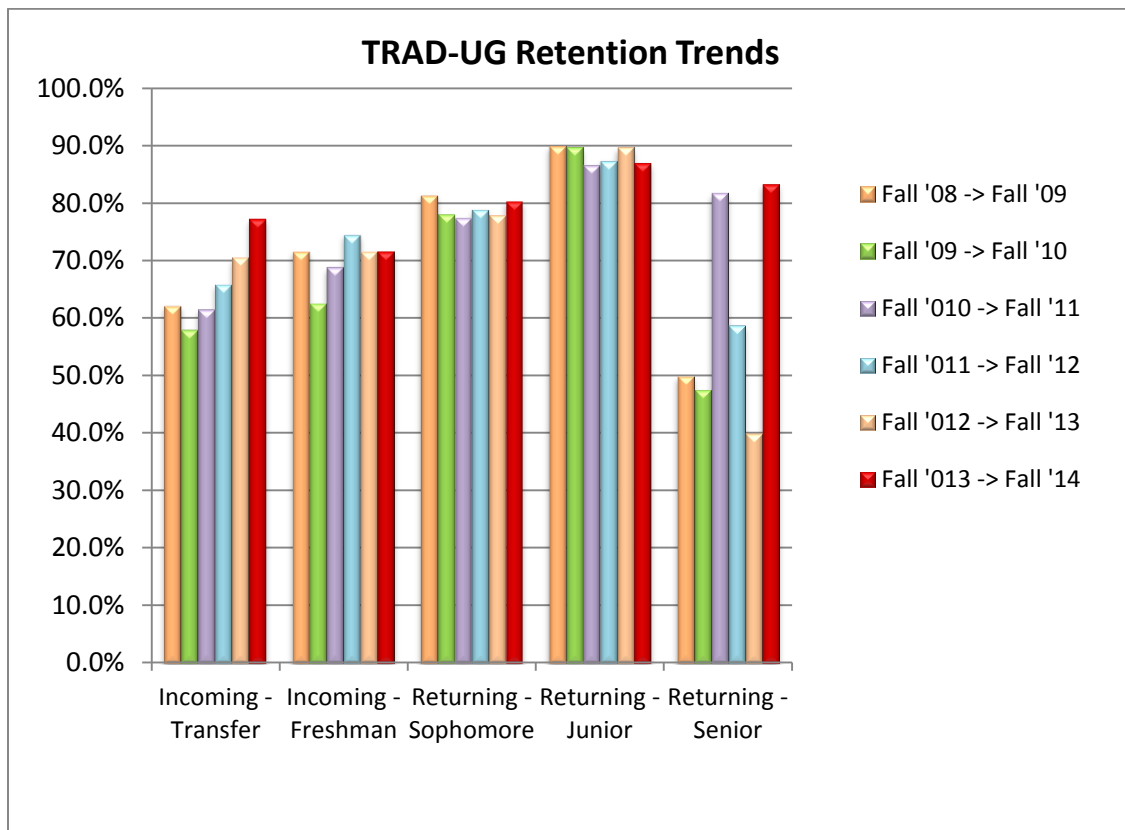
