

- Baseball record: Steven Pesce (Harrison, NY) collected his program-record 179th career hit.
- 100th victory: Earlier this month, baseball's head coach Chris Shank picked up this 100th career victory against Penn State-Berks on March 5th.
- First collegiate win: The Lions topped Cornell College on March 3rd to notch softball head coach Claire Roll's first collegiate career victory.
- First goal in ENC history: Jimmy Keuther (Marshfield, MA) buried Eastern Nazarene College's first-ever goal for the inaugural lacrosse season during the March 13th game against Albertus Magnus.


