




Lahue Revitalization



2021 Alumni Award Winners

Throughout the summer and fall, the Office of Advancement & External Relations has highlighted alumni award recipients to be honored at ENC's 2021 Homecoming. Below, please find an overview of the awards,

accompanied by biographical sketches for each award recipient. Celebrate with us as we **honor our deserving alumni!**

ENC Lifetime Service Award

Lifetime Service Awards are awarded to alumni who graduated more than 50 years ago and have evidenced a lifelong commitment to God and Alma Mater through service to Christ and the Kingdom while embodying the ENC Ideal.

As honorary alumni, ENC honors **Rev. Dr. Tom Barnard**, and his late wife, **Mrs. Madelyn Barnard**, for their lifelong devotion to God, their family, and the Church of the Nazarene. For over 65 years, from coast to coast, Dr. and Mrs. Barnard embraced adventures in ministry.

In 1982 the Barnards came to ENC, where Dr. Barnard served for nineteen years as Vice President for Student Development then as Vice President for Institutional Advancement. Dr. Barnard served three campus presidents – Stephen Nease, Cecil Paul, and Kent Hill.



During their tenure at ENC, Mrs. Barnard volunteered at events of the College and the Wollaston Church of the Nazarene. She also worked in the College Business Office.

In 2001, Dr. and Mrs. Barnard retired and relocated to Oklahoma City. They have two adult children, three grandchildren, and one great-grandchild.

Dr. Hazel Goodwin Kim '57

graduated from ENC with a Pre-Med degree, and in 1961 earned a medical degree from McGill University of Montreal, Quebec. She is a Developmental-Behavioral Pediatric Specialist in Brooklyn, NY and has over 60 years of experience in this specialty. During her pediatric residency, Dr. Goodwin met her husband, Dr. Hae Ahm Kim, who was a resident in Psychiatry.

After her residency, she served on a team with Dr. Margaret Lawrence, an African American child psychiatrist to evaluate children ages 0 to 5 years and learned the importance of understanding children's feelings and their families' reactions and interpretations.

Dr. Goodwin went on to hold pediatric appointments with Helen Hayes Hospital, Woodhull Hospital and Medical Center, Downstate University

Hospital, Brookdale University Hospital, and The Presbyterian Hospital in the City of New York. Dr. Goodwin served as Clinical Assistant Professor at New York Health Science Center at Brooklyn and Columbia University. She is the author of several book reviews and journal articles.

From 2007 until her retirement in 2019, Dr. Goodwin ran a private practice of developmental and behavioral pediatrics, engaging with parents, grandparents, and siblings, as well as teachers and psychologists, in the NYC school system on behalf of children in her practice.
