Commencement Weekend – Class of 2024

Baccalaureate:

Graduates and their families are invited to attend the Baccalaureate Service. Plan to join this worship service on **Friday, May 3, 2024 at 7:00 p.m.** for both traditional and adult & graduate studies members of the Class of 2024. Students should meet in the Mann Student Center at 6:15 p.m. with academic regalia. In case of rain, assemble in the Metcalfe Gathering Room in the lower level of the Wollaston Church. Immediately following the Baccalaureate Service there will be a reception for all graduating students and their guests in the Lahue Physical Education Center (Gymnasium).

Commencement:

Commencement is Saturday, May 4, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. Commencement will take place on the lawn in front of Gardner Hall. Graduation participants should plan to arrive on campus and meet at the Lahue Physical Education Center at 1:00 p.m. in order to receive directions. If you have guests with disabilities that need assistance once on campus please inform us as soon as possible. Guests can also view video streaming of the ceremony in the Wollaston Church of the Nazarene.

Please note that any student with an outstanding balance with the college will not be allowed to participate in Commencement.

Regalia:

Students must be financially and academically cleared for regalia to be released. Regalia will not be released until Student Financial Services (SFS) provides their approval. Regalia will be available for pick up at the Registrar's Office beginning April 22, 2024. From Monday, April 22 until Friday, April 26, pick up will be between the hours of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. From Monday, April 29 until Friday, May 3, pick up will be between the hours of 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. If you have extenuating circumstances that make it impossible for you to come to campus to pick up your regalia, please contact us by April 22, 2024 so we can work with you to mail the packet and ensure a timely delivery.

Rain Plan:

In case of rain the Lahue Physical Education Center will be used. All graduation participants will each receive five (5) guest tickets for live viewing of the ceremony in the Gymnasium. Other guests can view video streaming of the ceremony in the Wollaston Church of the Nazarene. Ceremony tickets will only be necessary in case of rain, and will need to be presented by guests at the door on their way into Lahue. Tickets will be included with your regalia. If we move the event to Lahue you will receive notification to your ENC email, via e2campus, as well as a posting on the ENC website. These notifications will be posted no later than 10:00 a.m. Saturday morning.
